



Field Training Guide for Biomedical Department Students

1. Introduction

This guide aims to introduce students of the Department of Biomedical Engineering to the systems and regulations of field training courses, which are considered basic courses within the courses of the Biomedical Engineering and Systems program, and the student is required to pass these courses to obtain a bachelor's degree

2. Internship Period

The field training period shall not be less than the number of training hours stipulated for each course in accordance with the course regulations, and the student shall train during the summer semester period after the end of the second semester exams. In the event that the student fails by the evaluation committee, the course will be repeated again during the holidays during the academic year.

3. Training Venues

Training takes place inside the Arab Republic of Egypt, and students who enjoy the residence of one of the foreign countries can train abroad, provided that the student is provided with evidence of the student's residence outside the Republic during the training period.

4. Training Grades

It is calculated through discussion or written exam after the student completes the training form in addition to the training certificate from the training authority by the grades stipulated in



accordance with the regulation, the cumulative total of the student is added

5. Submit the training form

The training forms approved by the training authority are delivered to the training department at the institute on the dates specified later and are evaluated by a committee in accordance with the decision of the department council to form the summer training committee

6. Training Courses

The training for each group is based on the summer training plan according to the decision of the program director
